The contest is open to everyone, with a particular emphasis on amateur or "hobbyist" bakers. To enter, simply pick a recipe and bake something! What you make is largely open-ended and left to your discretion: cookies, cakes, muffins, pies, etc. are all fair game. If you are unsure if your recipe would be a fitting entry for the contest, you can contact us using the information above to ask—but the answer is most likely yes.

In addition to the actual baked goods, you'll need to complete the attached entry form and write or type out a complete copy of the recipe you followed. Bring these along with your baked goods to the Boultenhouse Heritage Centre on Thursday, July 20<sup>th</sup> by no later than 7:15pm. We need to make sure all the entries are ready to go before the contest starts at 7:30!

The entries will be sampled by our panel of judges, all of whom are professional bakers in the Sackville community. They will assess each entry based on three categories: taste, creativity, and presentation. The judges will announce a winner and a runner-up who will both receive prizes, including gift certificates to local businesses.

All of the entries will then be auctioned off to the attendees, with the proceeds going to fund the Tantramar Heritage Trust, our museums, and future events. The runner-up and winning entries will be auctioned off second-last and last, respectively. The highest bidder for each entry will receive not only the baked goods in question, but also the copy of the recipe.
